Let Us “Love One Another”
Wednesday, May 25 at 7:30pm via Zoom

What does it mean for us to “love one another”? What do we do to demonstrate our love for our neighbor?

Over the past several weeks we witnessed hateful murders of Asian and Black Americans in Texas, California and New

York. Last week [GBH reported](#) about the growing Neo-Nazi movement in Massachusetts and New England. These are reminders of the importance and urgency of the work the parish has begun to learn, discuss, reflect, and ultimately to act — to combat the pervasive sin of racism. As was stated in the Redeemer's Leadership Statement on Race almost two years ago: "We cannot claim the Christian faith for ourselves as set forth in the Baptismal Covenant and remain silent or neutral in the face of racism."
